biography

described as a “maven of multifacetation” and a “creative force to be reckoned with,” gracyn blu (mezzo-soprano) is a los angeles–based vocalist, composer, and multi-instrumentalist. her vocal artistry is grounded in classical training, earning a bfa in vocal performance from carnegie mellon university but shaped by a lifelong curiosity across genres. her voice is known for its warmth, clarity, and adaptability, with a range that allows her to move fluidly between soprano and alto. a three-time encouragement award recipient in the metropolitan opera laffont competition, gracyn brings a wide-ranging, collaborative spirit to every musical space she enters.

gracyn’s love for choral music began early, sparked by singing with the acda national treble choir as a teenager. since then, she has appeared as a soloist with the bach choir of pittsburgh, the college light opera company, and ensembles across the country. since moving to los angeles, she has performed frequently in recitals and new-music programs. known for her sharp musicianship and unstoppable sight-reading skills, she is steadily carving out her place in the southern california choral scene, singing with choral arts initiative, voices of terpsichor, and more. gracyn is also a roster artist with pacific opera project, appearing regularly in recitals, concerts, and outreach programs.

alongside her classical work, gracyn is a songwriter, multi-instrumentalist and producer with a distinct approach to vocal composition, arrangement, and production. she is currently developing her debut project, a vocal-driven work that weaves together her classical foundation and pop sensibilities.
